

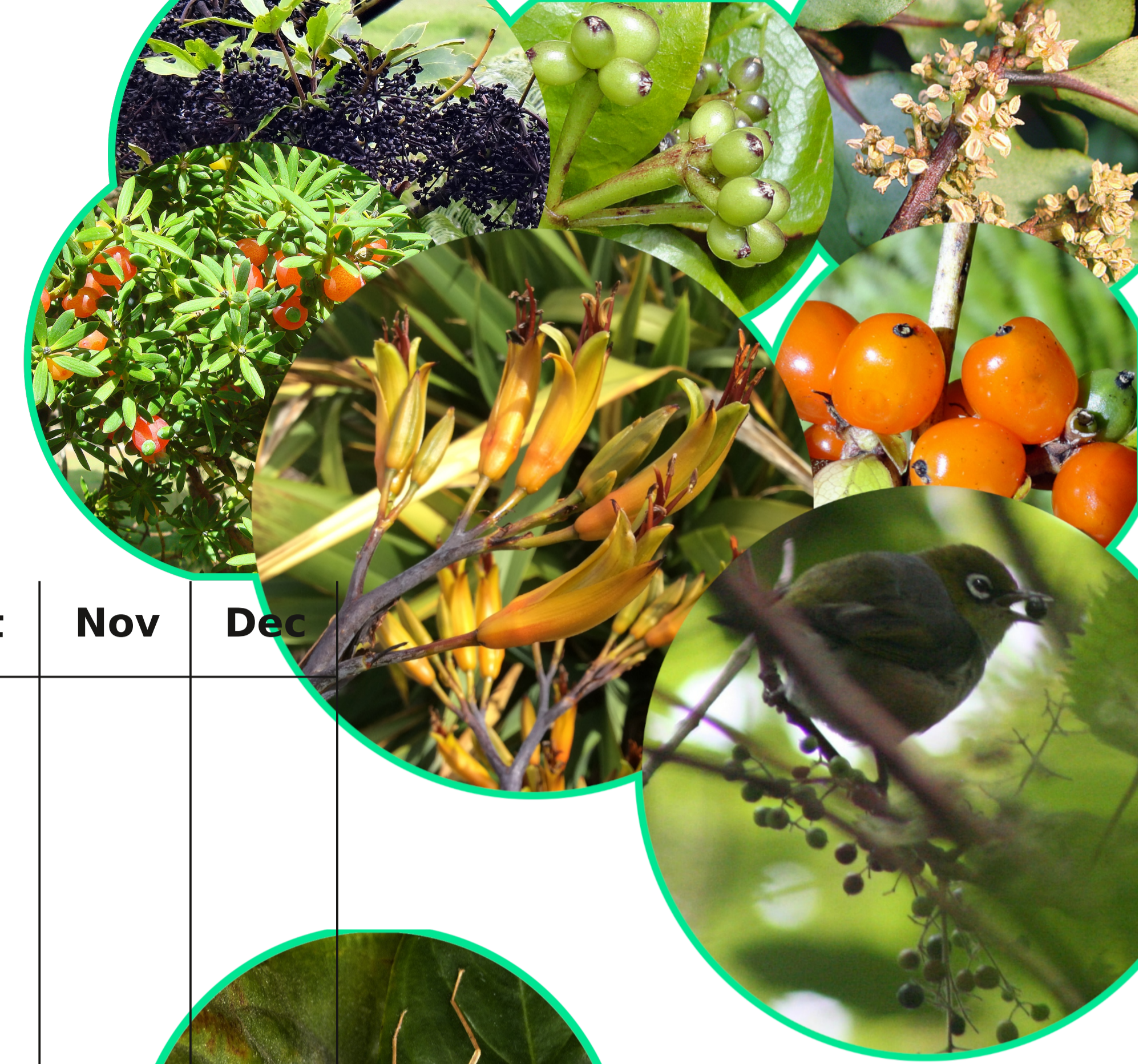


When choosing the plants for the red zone, it was important that some bird food was available all year.





























































